

<u>Officers Meeting Held:</u> A meeting was held on January 5th. Attending were Julia Palmer, Megan Divyak, Deb Young and Deb Thiel. Areas discussed were: program, Finance, Bylaws, Leadership, Strategic Planning, Public Policy and AAU Website.

Regarding Finance:

- Tomah Chamber of Commerce membership fees were approved in our 2020/21 budget, so e will go forward with that.
- National Dues will be increasing by \$3 next year and then by\$5 and \$5 the following years (\$62, \$67, \$72).
- The Wisconsin Technical College scholarship recipients are in process.

National Conference of College Women Student Leaders:

The NCCWSL program (National Conference for College Women Student Leaders) will be virtual this year and something our local Branch members should become more aware of so that we can encourage participation by friends, family, community members, neighbors, co-workers with collage students to apply. https://www.nccwsl.org

AAUW-WI has announced 12 scholarships of \$125 each to Wisconsin students to attend NCWSL for 2021. The conference dates are May 25 & 26, 2001. The scholarship will cover registration fees.

Eligible nominees must be currently enrolled in a program leading to an Associate degree (or equivalent), Bachelor's degrees, or Master's degree at a technical college or other two or four year pubic or private

college. Candidates must be nominated by an AAUW Branch with a limit of one nominee per branch. We will need to know of any interested applicants since there is an early March deadline for submission.
